First Aid & Emergencies

The CFA Meeting Room has been established as a temporary medical centre and will be manned by St John's Ambulance volunteers on Saturday.

Toilets

There are public toilets at the corner of Brown & Perkins Streets and next to the Caravan Park. The Hotel and Café also have toilets, as does the Memorial Hall.

Opening Ceremony

You will see Jed Culligan with his mobile microphone around the town. Jed will host the opening ceremony, which will be more modest than that of the Sochi Olympics.

Volunteers are here to help

There will be many volunteers in t-shirts roaming the streets. If you need help, guidance, directions, please stop a volunteer and speak nicely to them.

Live Radio

Radio Mansfield 99.7 will have an outside broadcast unit parked near Perkins & Brown Streets. They will broadcast live from Jamieson for the entire day.

Tour de Flavour

About 250 cyclists from the Tour de Flavour will stop for lunch in Jamieson, enroute from Mirimbah to Mansfield.

Respect for Township

Please bear in mind that this event is entirely run by volunteers. It would be a great help if you are considerate in your handling of litter, noise, smoking, etc.

Weather

We have tried to anticipate adverse weather, both rain and Total Fire Ban. Most events are under cover but the bush-cooking might be limited in the event of a TFB.

You'd be surprised how often there have been TFBs at this time of year.

If you lose something of value, contact a volunteer. Volunteers have radio contact with the organisers and Emergency Services.

Timing of Events

The Family Quiz around Jamieson is scheduled to take place between noon and 2:00pm, but you are free to take to the quiz trail at any time.

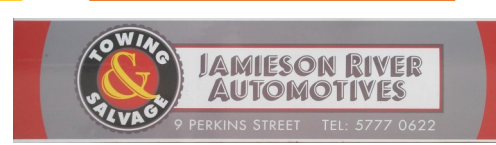
However, there may be no lollies left for those finishing in the late afternoon.

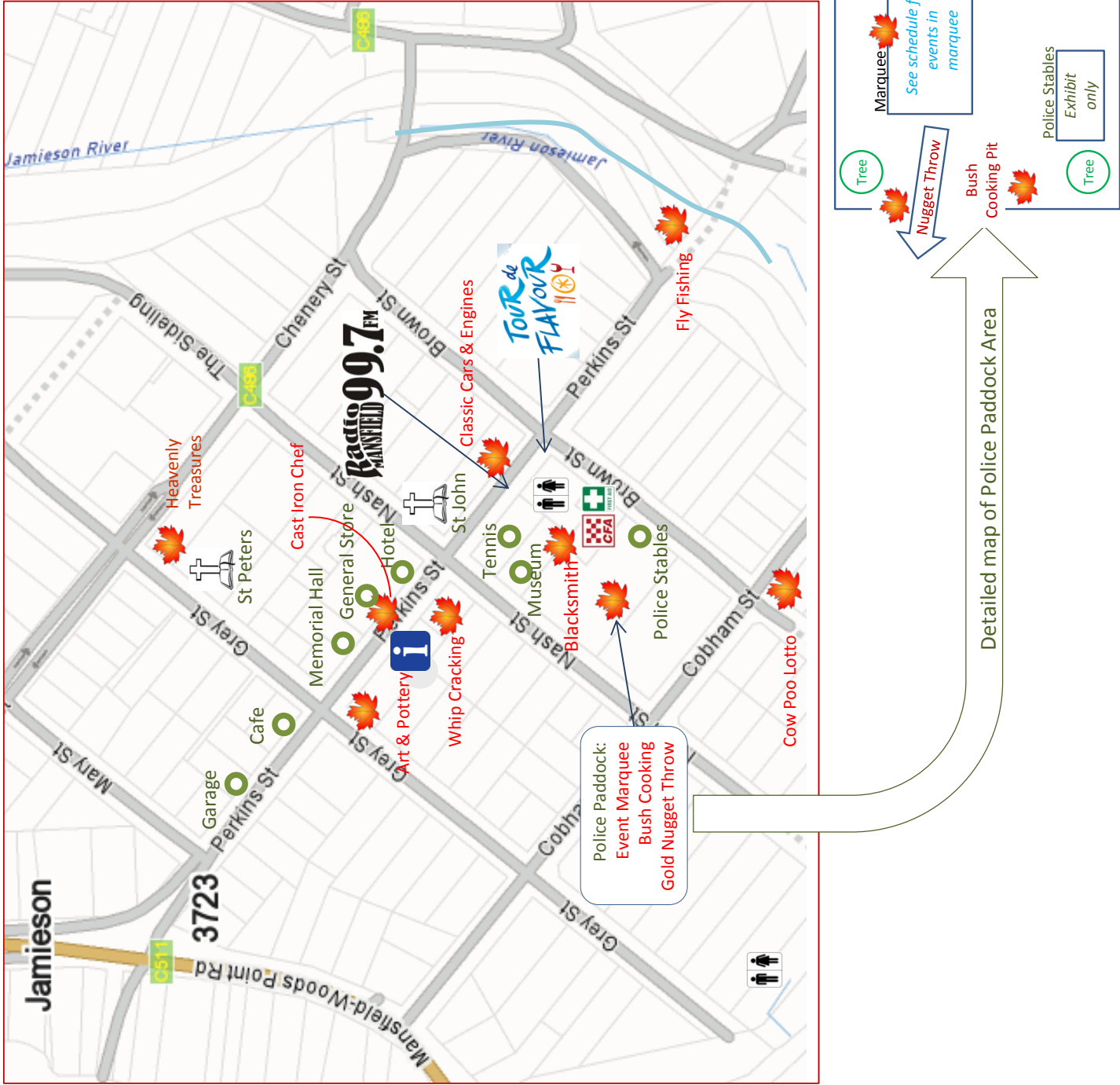
